CALL FOR PAPERS

The Leibniz Institute for Educational Trajectories (LIfBi) cordially invites to the 7th International NEPS Conference. By tradition, this conference brings together scientists from different disciplines and from different stages of the academic career to discuss their projects and findings in educational research. The framework is set up by the National Educational Panel Study (NEPS) with its six panel cohorts covering the entire life span and its thematic focuses on competence development, educational processes in different learning environments, educational decisions and social inequality, acquisition of education against the background of migration, returns to education, as well as motivational and personality-related aspects \rightarrow www.neps-data.de.

<u>Important note</u>: Due to the expected contact limitations in winter, the organizers have decided to conduct the conference one again as an online event.

Empirical contributions on all mentioned focuses, including methodological topics, are welcome. The analyses to be presented do not necessarily have to be based on NEPS data. In addition to the paper and poster presentations, we are very pleased to announce that Prof. Regina T. Riphahn, Ph.D. (Friedrich-Alexander-University Erlangen-Nuremberg) will give a keynote lecture at the conference. Also this year, the honoring of the best NEPS publication, which is endowed with EUR 1,000, takes place. Conference language is English.
