CALL FOR PAPERS

The Leibniz Institute for Educational Trajectories (LfBi) cordially invites to the 9th International NEPS Conference. By tradition, this conference brings together scientists from different disciplines and from different stages of their academic career to discuss current projects and findings in educational research. The framework is set up by the National Educational Panel Study (NEPS) with its six panel cohorts covering the entire life span and with its focuses on competence development, educational processes in different learning environments, educational decisions and social inequality, the acquisition of education against the background of migration, returns to education, as well as motivational and personality-related aspects → [Link to the NEPS website](#).

Empirical contributions on all mentioned topics, including methodological issues, are welcome. The analyses do not necessarily have to be based on NEPS data; other data sources are also possible. There will be paper as well as poster presentations and the granting of the NEPS Publication Award. The event takes place on site at the LfBi in Bamberg; for some of the talks we are planning an additional online stream. Conference language is English. Abstract: The abstract should contain a brief description of the research question, the data source used, the theoretical approach and the most important results in a maximum of **400 words**.

Also indicate the title of the contribution, the name and institutional affiliation of the presenter(s), and the preferred format as **paper or poster** presentation.

Submission: Please send your abstract, preferably as Word file, to neps-conference@lifbi.de.

Deadline for submission is **September 15, 2024**.

All authors will receive a notification of acceptance by **September 30, 2024**.

Registration: Participation in the conference is possible with and without an own contribution. However, registration is required for all participants. The respective online form on the conference website will be available from **August 1, 2024**.

Financing: There is no conference fee to pay. Participants are asked to cover their own travel and accommodation costs.
