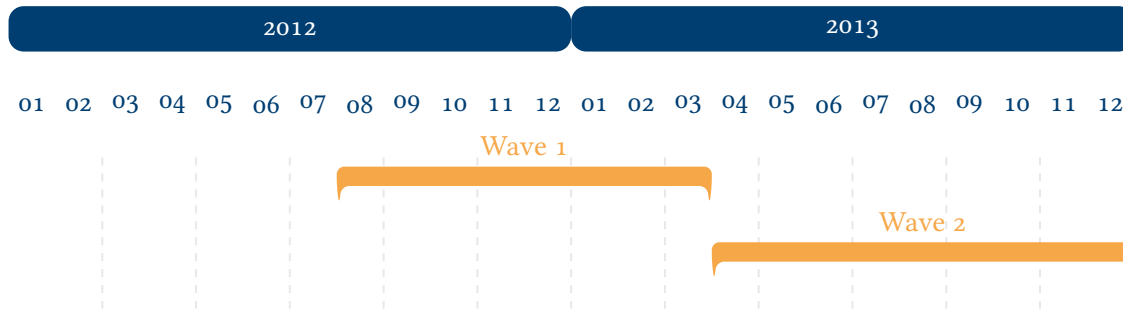

# Surveys of Starting Cohort 1 – Early Childhood

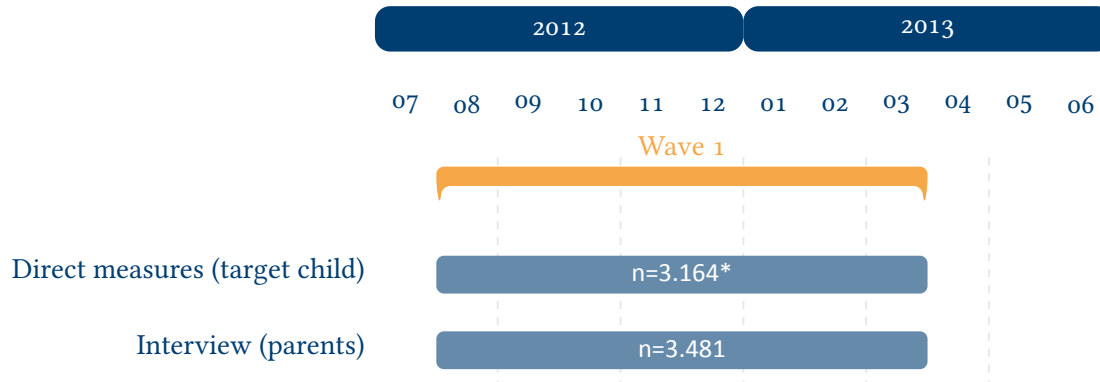


**Figure 1:** Survey progress of Starting Cohort 1 (waves 1 and 2)

The present study documentation gives an overview of the progress of the main surveys, which will contribute to the Scientific Use Files (SUFs). Figure 1 presents a general view on the field times of the target persons for waves 1 and 2.

In the wave-specific overviews starting from section 1 not only the questioned target and context persons are defined but the case numbers and field times, as well. This information is taken from the corresponding field and method reports and might differ slightly from the numbers in the data sets of the SUFs. **Sample** Individual sample

**2 Context persons** Parents (esp. mothers)

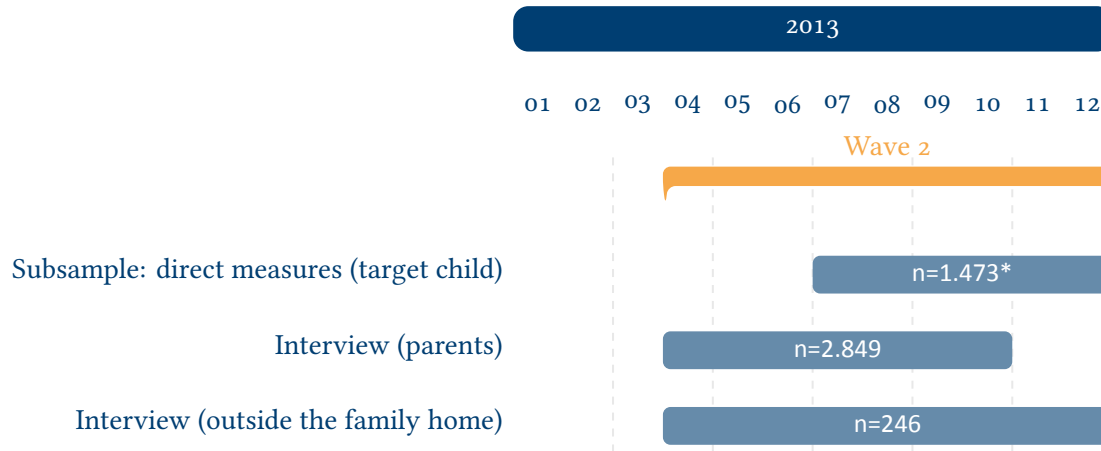
**Definition** The parents of the children (target persons) included in the sample are invited to participate.

**3 Data collection** infas - Institute for Applied Social Sciences, Bonn

**4 Mode of survey** Survey of direct measures with target child (parents-child-interaction, sensorimotoric development and habituation), computer-assisted interview of parents (CAPI)

**1 Mater sample** 6-8 month-old infants (entering the panel in 2012/2013)

**Target persons** 12-17 month-old infants

**Sample** Individual sample

**2 Context persons**

**2.1 Context persons** Parents (esp. mothers)

**Definition** The parents of the children (target persons) included in the sample are invited to participate.

**2.2 Context persons** Persons in charge outside the family home (group manager day nursery/kinder-garten and home-based childminders)

**Definition** The parents pass the questioning to the external persons in charge.

**3 Data collection** infas - Institute for Applied Social Sciences, Bonn

**4 Mode of survey** Survey of direct measures with the target child (parents-child-interaction and habituation), computer-assisted interviews of the parents (CATI or CAPI), written questionnaires for the persons in charge outside the family home (PAPI)
