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Surveys of Starting Cohort 1 – Early Childhood




Figure 1: Survey progress of Starting Cohort 1 (waves 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6)

The present study documentation gives an overview of the progress of the main surveys, which will contribute to the Scientific Use Files (SUFs). Figure 1 presents a general view on the field times of the target persons for waves 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6.

In the wave-specific overviews starting from section 1 not only the questioned target and context persons are defined but the case numbers and field times, as well. - Context persons
 - Parents (esp. mothers)

Mode of survey computer-assisted interviews (CAPI)

Initial sample 6-8 month-old infants (entering the panel in 2012/2013)

- **Mode of survey** video-based survey of direct measures (parents-child-interaction and habituation)
- Context persons
 - Parents (esp. mothers)

Mode of survey computer-assisted interviews (CAPI) for the parents within the subsample respectively computer-assisted telefphone interviews (CAPI) for the remaining parents

 Persons in charge outside the family home (group manager day nursery/kindergarten and home-based childminders)

Mode of survey the parents pass the written questionnaires (PAPI) to the external persons in charge

Current wave 25-27 month-old infants

Initial sample 6-8 month-old infants (entering the panel in 2012/2013)

Mode of survey video-based survey of direct measures (parents-child-interaction)

- Context persons
 - Parents (esp. mothers)

Mode of survey computer-assisted interviews (CAPI) or computer-assisted telefphone interviews (CAPI) and questionnaire on the vocabulary of the child

 Persons in charge outside the family home (group manager day nursery/kindergarten and home-based childminders)

Mode of survey the parents pass the written questionnaires (PAPI) to the external persons in charge

 - Parents (esp. mothers)

Mode of survey computer-assisted interviews parents (CAPI/CATI) and questionnaire on the vocabulary of the child

 Persons in charge outside the family home (institution manager and group manager day care center/kindergarten)

Mode of survey computer-assisted interviews parents (CAPI/CATI) and questionnaire on the behaviour of the child (PAPI)

 Persons in charge outside the family home (institution manager and group manager day care center/kindergarten)

Mode of survey paper-based interview persons in charge outside the family home (PAPI)

Target persons

Current wave approx. 48 month-old children

Initial sample 6-8 month-old infants (entering the panel in 2012/2013)

- **Mode of survey** tablet-based test (CBT) of direct measures (recording of executive functions, tasks in the area of mathematics)
- Context persons
 - Parents (The parents of the children (target persons) included in the sample were again invited to participate.)

Mode of survey computer-assisted interviews parents (CAPI/CATI) and questionnaire on the behaviour of the child (PAPI)

 Persons in charge outside the family home (institution manager and group manager day care center/kindergarten)

Mode of survey paper-based interview persons in charge outside the family home (PAPI)

Target persons

Current wave approx. 60 month-old children

Initial sample 6-8 month-old infants (entering the panel in 2012/2013)

Mode of survey tablet-based test (TBT) of direct measures (testing delayed gratification, vocabulary testing, tasks in the field of science)

- Context persons
 - Parents (the parents of the children (target persons) included in the sample)
 - **Mode of survey** computer-assisted interviews parents (CAPI or CATI) and questionnaire on behaviour and characteristics of the child, self-assessment of the interviewed parent and joint activities with the target child (PAPI)
 - Persons in charge outside the family home (institution manager and group manager kindergarten)
