


Figure 1: Survey progress of Starting Cohort 1 (waves 1, 2, 3 and 4)




Figure 2: Field times and realized case number in wave 1

Mode of survey video-based survey of direct measures (parents-child-interaction, senso-motoric development and habituation)

- Context persons
 - Parents (esp. mothers)

Mode of survey computer-assisted interviews (CAPI)




Figure 3: Field times and realized case number in wave 2

Mode of survey computer-assisted interviews (CAPI) for the parents within the subsample respectively computer-assisted telefphone interviews (CATI) for the remaining parents

 Persons in charge outside the family home (group manager day nursery/kindergarten and home-based childminders)

Mode of survey the parents pass the written questionnaires (PAPI) to the external persons in charge




Figure 4: Field times and realized case number in wave 3




Figure 5: Field times and realized case number in wave 4

 - Parents (esp. mothers)

Mode of survey computer-assisted interviews (CAPI) or computer-assisted telefphone interviews (CATI) and questionnaire on the vocabulary of the child

 Persons in charge outside the family home (institution manager and group manager day nursery/kindergarten)

Mode of survey paper and pencil interviews (PAPI)
