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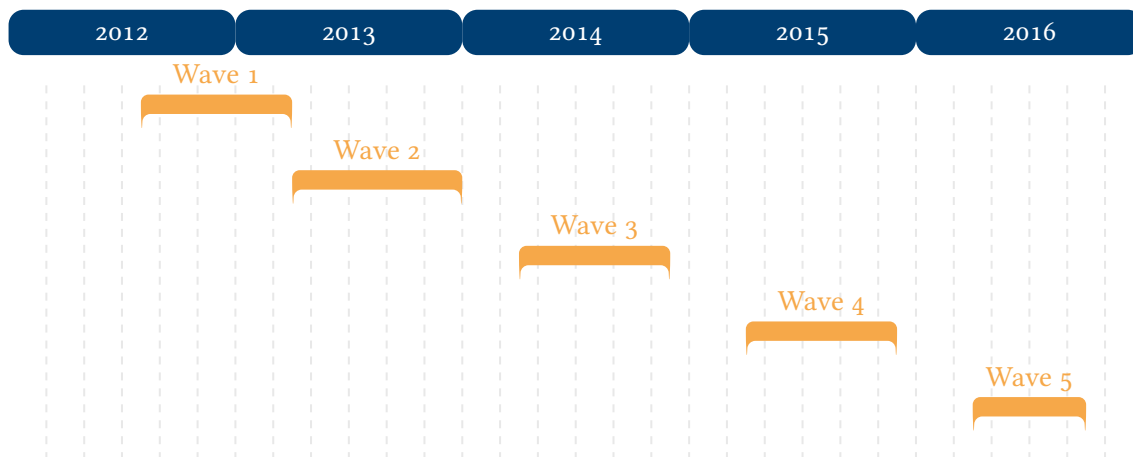


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# Surveys of Starting Cohort 1 – Early Childhood

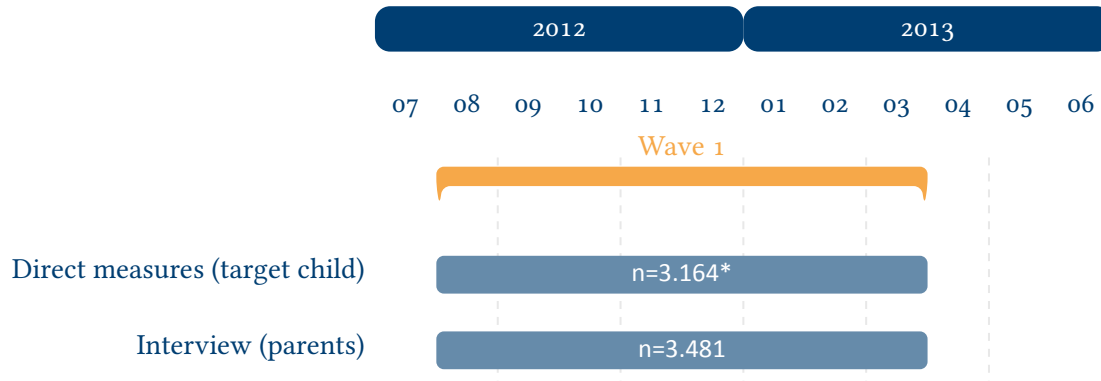
**Figure 1:** Survey progress of Starting Cohort 1 (waves 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5)

The present study documentation gives an overview of the progress of the main surveys, which will contribute to the Scientific Use Files (SUFs). Figure 1 presents a general view on the field times of the target persons for waves 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5.

In the wave-specific overviews starting from section 1 not only the questioned target and context persons are defined but the case numbers and field times, as well. 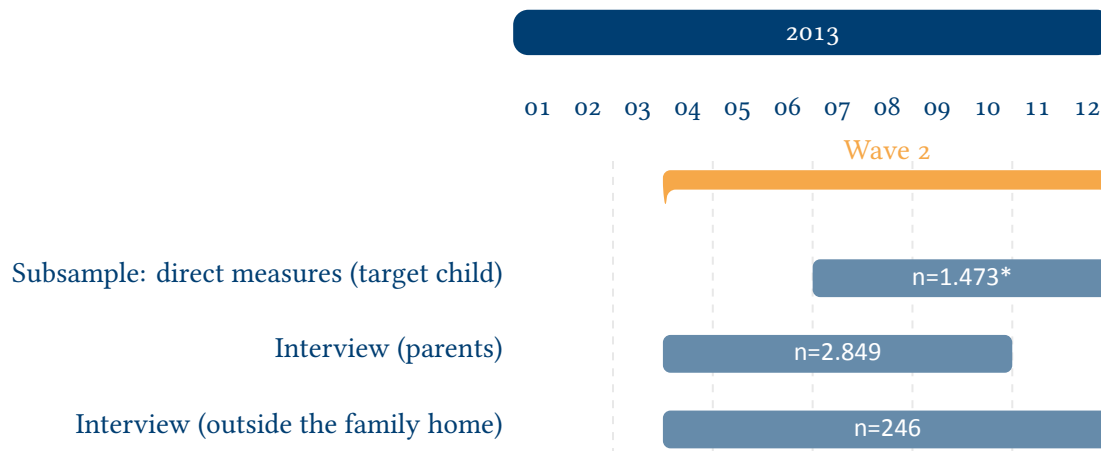
## 1 Wave 1: Main Survey 2012/13

- Target persons
  - Current wave** 6-8 month-old infants
  - Initial sample** 6-8 month-old infants (entering the panel in 2012/2013)
  - Mode of survey** video-based survey of direct measures (parents-child-interaction, sensorimotoric development and habituation)
- Context persons
  - Parents (esp. mothers)
    - Mode of survey** computer-assisted interviews (CAPI)

## 2 Wave 2: Main Survey 2013

- Target persons

**Current wave** Subsample of 12-17 month-old infants

**Initial sample** 6-8 month-old infants (entering the panel in 2012/2013)

**Mode of survey** video-based survey of direct measures (parents-child-interaction and habituation)

- Context persons

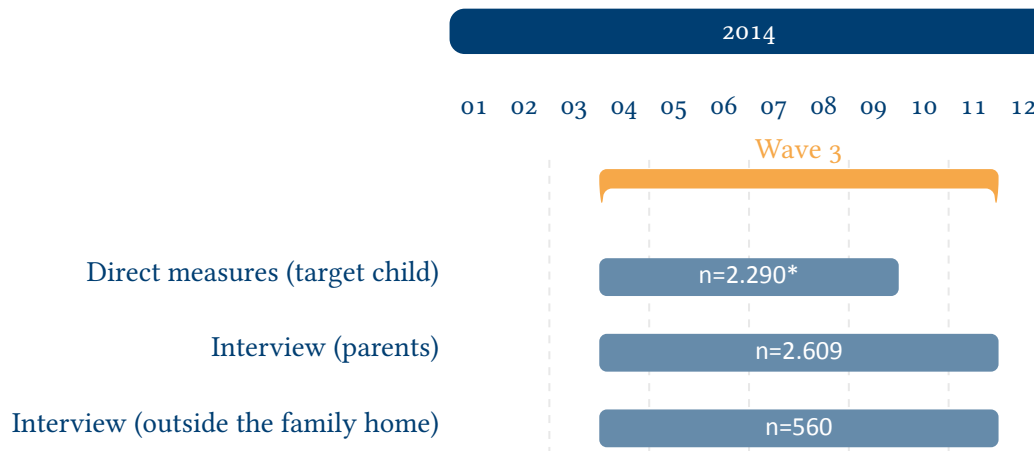
- Parents (esp. mothers)

**Mode of survey** computer-assisted interviews (CAPI) for the parents within the subsample respectively computer-assisted telephone interviews (CAPI) for the remaining parents

- Persons in charge outside the family home (group manager day nursery/kindergarten and home-based childminders)

**Mode of survey** the parents pass the written questionnaires (PAPI) to the external persons in charge

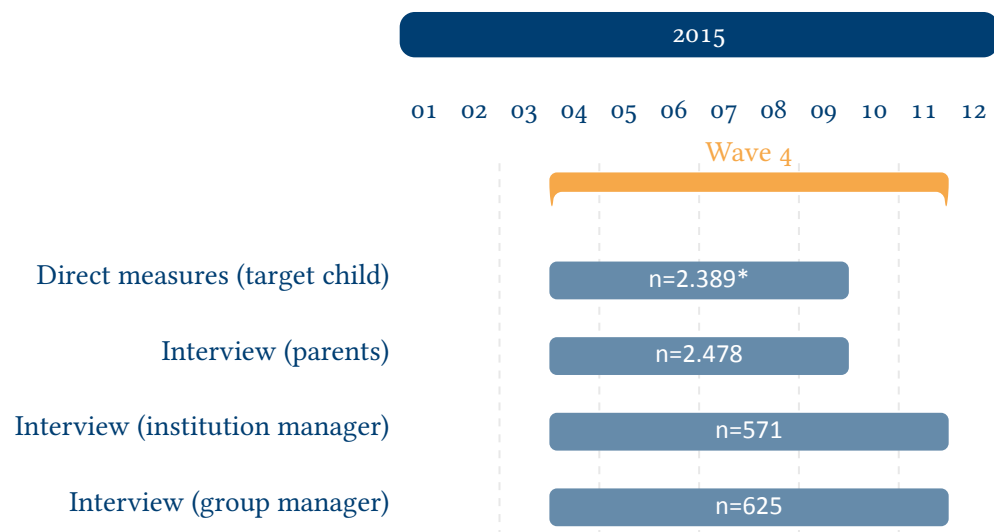
# 3 Wave 3: Main Survey 2014

- Target persons
  - Current wave** 25-27 month-old infants
  - Initial sample** 6-8 month-old infants (entering the panel in 2012/2013)
  - Mode of survey** video-based survey of direct measures (parents-child-interaction)
- Context persons
  - Parents (esp. mothers)
    - Mode of survey** computer-assisted interviews (CAPI) or computer-assisted telephone interviews (CAPI) and questionnaire on the vocabulary of the child
  - Persons in charge outside the family home (group manager day nursery/kindergarten and home-based childminders)
    - Mode of survey** the parents pass the written questionnaires (PAPI) to the external persons in charge

# 4 Wave 4: Main Survey 2015

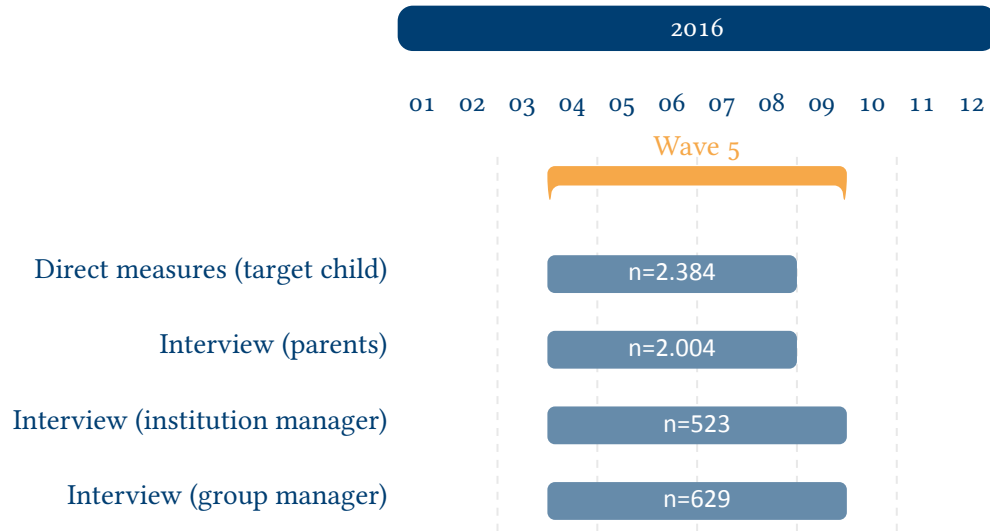


**Figure 5:** Field times and realized case number in wave 4

- Target persons
  - Current wave** 37-39 month-old infants
  - Initial sample** 6-8 month-old infants (entering the panel in 2012/2013)
  - Mode of survey** computer-based test (CBT) of direct measures (Vocabulary, Categorization, Delayed Gratification, Digit Span)
- Context persons
  - Parents (esp. mothers)
    - Mode of survey** computer-assisted interviews parents (CAPI/CATI) and questionnaire on the vocabulary of the child
  - Persons in charge outside the family home (institution manager and group manager day care center/kindergarten)
    - Mode of survey** computer-assisted interviews parents (CAPI/CATI) and questionnaire on the behaviour of the child (PAPI)
  - Persons in charge outside the family home (institution manager and group manager day care center/kindergarten)
    - Mode of survey** paper-based interview persons in charge outside the family home (PAPI)



# 5 Wave 5: Main Survey 2016

- Target persons
  - Current wave** approx. 48 month-old children
  - Initial sample** 6-8 month-old infants (entering the panel in 2012/2013)
  - Mode of survey** tablet-based test (CBT) of direct measures (recording of executive functions, tasks in the area of mathematics)
- Context persons
  - Parents (The parents of the children (target persons) included in the sample were again invited to participate.)
    - Mode of survey** computer-assisted interviews parents (CAPI/CATI) and questionnaire on the behaviour of the child (PAPI)
  - Persons in charge outside the family home (institution manager and group manager day care center/kindergarten)
    - Mode of survey** paper-based interview persons in charge outside the family home (PAPI)
